The (Name of the person/applicant **Mangalwati Sewa Sadan for Educational Research & Social Welfare, Sonari, Jamshedpur-831 011** has applied for establishment of a Dental College at **Danga, Jamshedpur(East Singhbhum)**.

On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of **Jharkhand** has issued certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a Dental College with **100(Hundered) Seats**.

It is certified that :-

(a) The applicant owns and manages a 100 bedded hospital which was established in - **N.A.**

Or

Where no Medical College is available in the proximity of the proposed Dental College, the proposed Dental College shall get itself tied up for at least for 20 years with a Govt. General Hospital which is having provision for at least 100 beds and which is located within 10 K.M. by road of the proposed Dental College till they have their own hospital in the same premises. It shall be the duty of the applicant to produce evidence that the infrastructure(facilities) such as teaching, pre-clinical, para-clinical and allied medical sciences are owned by the proposed Dental College itself :- **The Awadh Dental College has tied up with the local T.M.H., Jamshedpur having good faculty of Dentistry as well as allied subject. The T.M.H. is nearly 9 k.m. from the proposed Awadh Dental College at Danga, Jamshedpur(East Singhbhum) and it shall be tied up with it till the development of its own infrastructure.**

(b) The applicant owns and manages a Dental Hospital of **Danga, Jamshedpur(East Singhbhum)** as mentioned in clause(a).

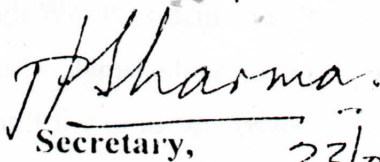
(c) It is desirable to establish a Dental College in the public interest - **Yes.**

(d) Establishment of a Dental College at **Danga, Jamshedpur(East Singhbhum)** by (the name of **Awadh Dental College, Jamshedpur**) is feasible.

(e) Minimum 30 OPD Dental patients per day are available to begin with.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Dental College as per Dental Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Dental Council of India, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.
