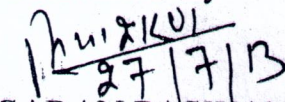

On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Jharkhand has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for starting P.G. Course in Awadh Dental College & Hospital, Jamshedpur with **24 Nos.(twenty four) seats. [03 seats in each speciality comprising of Eight speciality in M.D.S. course].**

It is certified that;-

- (a) The applicant owns and manages a -----bedded hospital which was established in ----- - **N.A.**

Or

The proposed Dental College is located in the proximity of ----- Medical College recognized by MCI and has also obtained an undertaking from the said Medical College that would facilitate training to the students of the proposed Dental College in the subject of Medicine, Surgery and Allied Medical Sciences.

Since no Medical College is available in the proximity of the proposed Dental College, the proposed Dental College has got itself tied up for 20 years with a Government General Hospital/Tata Main Hospital, which is having provision for 100 beds and which is located within 10 K.M. of radius of the proposed Dental College till they have their own hospital in the same premises. It shall be the duty of the applicant to produce evidence that the infrastructural facilities such as teaching, pre-clinical, para-clinical and allied medical sciences are owned by the proposed Dental College itself:-

(b)	The applicant owns and manages a dental clinic/hospital with 248 chairs	YES
(c)	It is desirable to establish a dental college in the public interest.	YES
(d)	Minimum 30 Out Door Dental patients per day are available to begin with.	YES
(e)	The credibility and the financial status of the applicant has been verified.	YES

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It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the dental college as per Dental Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Dental Council of India, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.
