Sir,

The desired certificate for Essentiality Certificate is as follows:-

1. No. of institutions already existing in the State - 3 (Three) B.D.S and 3 (Three) M.D.S Institutions
2. No. of seats available or No. of Surgeons being produced annually - --
3. No. of dental surgeons registered with the State Dental Council. - State Dental Council is yet to be formed (Health Ministry, GoI has initiated the process)
4. No. of Dental surgeons Government service - 33 (Thirty three)
5. No. of Government posts vacant and those in rural/difficult areas - 219 Post Vacant
6. No. of dental registered with Employment Exchange - N.A.
7. Dental surgeons population ratio in the State - Total Population of Jharkhand is 3,29,88,134 since State Dental Council is not in existence, hence it is not clear how many Dental Surgeons are there in the State. There may be some Dental Surgeons, who practice privately.
8. How the establishment of the College would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified dental personnel in the State and improve availability of such dental man power in the State - Introduction of M.D.S Course will provide specialized Dental care of the population residing within the state of Jharkhand and hence enhance the number of Qualified Dental Personnel in the state.
9. The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in State, be specified - Students who are not domiciled in the State, will have to serve the State of Jharkhand for atleast 8 (Eight) Years.
10. Full justification for opening of the proposed College - Presently U.G. College is recognized. and hence the same Institution is proposed to enhance the Department to introduce P.G Courses (M.D.S)
11. Dental surgeons-patient ratio proposed to be achieved - Dental Surgeon- Patient ratio will be achieved as per the norms of Dental Council of India .



12. Copy of the Inspection Report in connection with the Inspection carried out by the State Government for grant of permission for setting up a new dental college is be attached

The (Name of the person/applicant):- Awadh Dental college & Hospital "A unit of Manglawati Sewa Sadan Trust, 65 A, Sangam Vihar, Sonari, Jamshedpur" NH-33, Danga, P.O- Bhilaipahari, Jamshedpur, Dist.- East Singhbhum-831012, Jharkhand has applied for **increase 03 (three) Seats** each in Two Specialty (MDS)- Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics and prosthodontics and crown & Bridge as per MDS (PG) course regulation of Dental Council of India. On careful consideration of the proposal, The Govt. of Jharkhand has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant to increase seats of above department which already running both deptt. **in 02 seats each and with 03 (three) New seats total 05 (five) seats.**

It is certified that:-

(a) The proposed Dental College is located in the proximity of Medical College recognized by M.C.I. and has also obtained and undertaking from the said Medical College that would facilitate training to the students of the proposed Dental College in the subject of Medicine, Surgery and Allied Medical Sciences.

Since no Medical College is available in the proximity of the proposed Dental College, the proposed Dental College has got itself tied-up for 5 years with Government General /Sadar Hospital, East Singhbhum which is having provision for 100 beds and which is located within 10 K.M. of radius of the proposed Dental College till they have their own hospital in the same premises. It shall be the duty of the applicant to produce evidence that the infrastructural facilities such as teaching, pre-clinical, para-clinical and allied medical sciences are owned by the proposed Dental College itself.
