The proposed Dental College is located in the proximity of **7.1 K.M** from Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Hospital, Jamshedpur recognized by M.C.I. and has also obtained an undertaking from the said Medical College that would facilitate training to the students of the proposed Dental College in the subject of Medicine, Surgery and Allied Medical Sciences.

Since no Medical College is available in the proximity of the proposed Dental College, the proposed Dental College has got itself tied-up for 5 years with Government general Hospital, which is having provision for 100 beds and which is located within **7.1 K.M.** of radius of the Dental College till they have their own hospital in the same premises. It shall be the duty of the applicant to produce evidence that the infrastructural facilities such as teaching, pre-clinical, para-clinical and allied medical sciences are owned by the Dental College itself:-

The Awadh Dental College & Hospital has tied up with the M.G.M Medical College & Hospital, Jamshedpur, having good faculty of Dentistry and as well as allied subjects. The M.G.M Medical College is nearly 7.1 K.M from the Awadh Dental College & Hospital at Danga, Jamshedpur (East Singhbhum) and it shall be tied up with it till the development of its own infrastructure.
